

Building Resources into Developing Global English (BRIDGE) Course

L.J. Group of Education has formed an affiliation with Cambridge University through which it has started BRIDGE(Building Resources Into Developing Global English) program in all its campuses. In this program, the students are given the opportunity to enhance and develop their English communication skills through offering for different Cambridge English Exams. In the first cycle of this program, students have offered for BEC and PET Cambridge English Exams from which L.J. Institute of Applied Sciences offered PET (Preliminary English Test). Few selected faculty members of the institute, who have been explicitly trained by Cambridge officials, provide the students a thorough training for improving their reading, writing, listening and speaking skills in English. Extra training sessions are held for each module separately and students are also given mock tests before they appear for the Cambridge Exam on an International level. Those students who participate in this program are provided a certificate by Cambridge University as well as L.J. Institute stating their level of English according to the Cambridge CEFR level. These certificates provide the students extra credit points for their resume and they are also open to the opportunity of being recruited by other companies and Institutions affiliated with Cambridge.
