PRE-GPAT ONLINE EXAMINATION REPORT

L. J. Institute of Pharmacy has successfully taken an initiative to conduct an online PRE-GPAT examination for students of semester 8 as a distinctive approach towards the preparation of GPAT examination 2018. **This initiative was first of its kind among all colleges in Gujarat to conduct such pre GPAT online examination where the academic excellence of the students can be improved and making students more competent for entrance exams.**



The prime focus behind this examination was to provide student a similar ambience of examination as they have in competitive examinations. With this approach of online students were allowed to evaluate themselves with respect to knowledge and time frames in competitive exams.

The examination was conducted on 6th and 13th January, 2018. Total 26 students from 8th semester are currently preparing for the GPAT examination 2018 which will be held on **21.01.2018**. Out of 26 students 11 students appeared for the first Pre-GPAT examination and 18 students appeared for the second Pre-GPAT examination.

On the basis of results achieved by students in Pre-GPAT exams, each student was counseled for further improvement in exam with suitable guidance regarding pros and cons of negative markings in the exam.

The examination was conducted by the committee comprising of members of faculty Dr. Jignesh Shah, Mr. Kirtan Sanghvi, Mr. Jaymin Patel, Ms. Kaushika Patel, Mr. Jayesh Beladiya and Ms. Pooja Shah actively involved in the mentorship of students for GPAT. The examination was held at the computer lab, MBA building with the assistance of Dr. Alok Manke, Director LJMCA; Nazeer Shirazi and Mr. Amit Kataria.
