
Mr. Prashant Agnihotri, Head of Department Microbiology & Pathology, Ahmedabad Dental College, Bopal, Ahmedabad was invited on 08 Aug 2018, Wednesday to deliver a session on ‘Brief Insight on Clinical Diagnosis’. Mr. Agnihotri has begun his career in the field of Medical microbiology and Pathology and established his own laboratory in 1986. He acquired grounding knowledge on emerging technologies of clinical edges of pathological tests and microbiological cultures.

The lecture inaugurated with warm welcome of Mr. Prashant Agnihotri by Dr. Shreeraj Shah, Principal (I/C), LJIP with a Tulsi. Mr. Agnihotri, having more than 40 years of experience in the field of pathology, shared his knowledge and skills with more than 150 students along with faculties. Expertise and experience on following areas were shared by Mr. Agnihotri during the presentation

- ✚ Importance of pathology
- ✚ Interpretation of pathological reports with several case studies
- ✚ How errors in techniques used for blood collection can affect the interpretation
- ✚ Practicing medicines safely, confidently, rationally, effectively.
- ✚ Various laboratory tests and their interpretation such as Erythrocyte Sedimentation Rate (ESR), Complete Blood Count (CBC), Liver Function Test (LFT), Kidney Function Test, Lipid Profile.
- ✚ Brief insight on diabetes, arthritis, vitamin deficiency
- ✚ Difference between signs of Hepatitis-B and Falciparum Malaria.



With wide experience of field Mr. Agnihotri explained how to isolate and present oneself in market by utilizing such knowledge of pathophysiology. Mr. Agnihotri concluded the session with few advices about healthy living and utilization of pathological knowledge for society. After completion of session few students and faculties requested to provide brief insight on vitamin deficiency and ESR.
