

GUIDELINES FOR FILLING UP NRI QUOTA / NRI SPONSORED QUOTA SEATS AT LJIP FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2019-20

- (1) LJIP may admit students who have passed class XII or equivalent qualifying examination from Within / Outside Gujarat State with minimum eligibility criteria, on merit basis, on the sanctioned intake of 15% NRI / NRI Sponsored seats.
- (2) If the student has passed qualifying examination **from India**, and seeks admission under the **NRI sponsored** category, then he/she must have appeared GUJCET-2019 examination, then only he/she will be considered eligible for admission.
- (3) NRI sponsored student has to submit the requisite documents within stipulated timeline.
- (4) NRI sponsored students will be included in merit list of NRI seats

7	<p>An Affidavit from Sponsoring person as per prescribed Performa and should be submitted along with application / on or before counseling.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If the affidavit is being prepared in foreign country (Stamp Paper is not required), sponsor has to follow the affidavit/notarization of respective country. • If provision of notarization is not available in a particular country, sponsor has to get the affidavit endorsed from Indian Embassy/Indian Consulate situated in the respective country. • If affidavit procedure is being carried out in India (Stamp Paper is required) by NRI Sponsor, in that case proof of his/her presence in India at the time of affidavit must be enclosed which may be in the form of a photocopy of those pages of passport having immigration stamp. • The signature of the sponsor should be exactly match with his/her signature in the passport.

- (5) Priority would be given to NRI candidates for admission on NRI seats.
- (6) The NRI students who have passed qualifying examination **from outside India** would be exempted from GUJCET-2019 examination. They would be included in the merit list based on the marks obtained in the qualifying examination. In case, Letter Grade / Performance Index or Graded Point Average is awarded instead of percentage marks in qualifying examination, equivalence certificate is required from the school authority. Such candidates will have to fulfil the eligibility criteria prescribed by the State Government for admission.
- (7) The NRI students who have passed qualifying examination from outside India shall have to obtain equivalency certificate from Association of Indian Universities, Delhi.
- (8) NRI student who seeks admission on NRI seat will have to submit copy of his/her passport as well as passport of his/her mother and/or father, to prove himself/herself as an NRI candidate.

Following categories of people will be considered as NRI for admission to B.PHARM Programmes at LJIP.

- Candidates who have Passport indicating his/her status as 'Non Resident Indian'.
- Candidates who have a Certificate of 'Non Resident Indian' issued by the Indian Embassy/Indian Consulate of the Country where the candidate is residing.
- Overseas Citizen of India (OCI) card holders.
- Candidates who have studied outside India and have passed either 10th or 12th standard (or must be appearing for in 2019) or equivalent from any system of education subject to the eligibility conditions and have NRI status.

- (9) LJIP will follow the said guidelines scrupulously for filling up of NRI / NRI Sponsored Seats.
- (10) LJIP will conduct admission process in a fair, transparent & non-exploitative manner and no eligible candidate would be denied issuing or accepting his/her information form.

(11) The institute will maintain a record of distribution and acceptance of information forms in a separate register. The institute will prepare a merit list (inter-se) from the applications of eligible students who occupy merit number of Admission Committee. All the students included in the merit list must be present without fail on the announced date and place for counseling as per their inter-se merit. No preference or claim on any seat will be given to any absent candidate included in the inter-se merit list after his turn in the counseling process is over.
